

ORDINANCE 126

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 67, ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION AND CONTROL OF VEHICULAR TRAFFICE AND PARKING UPON THE STREETS, HIGHWAYS AND ROADS IN THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND SPECIFICALLY REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 10,22,23, AND 34 AND ANY AND ALL OTHER ORDINANCES AND SECTIONS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH” BY ADDING SECTION 306 RELATING TO TAXI STANDS, AND SECTION 307 PROHIBITING PARKING ON OCEAN PLACE BETWEEN 7 P.M. AND 7 A.M. DURING CERTAIN TIMES OF THE YEAR.

BE It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Loch Arbour, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION A. Ordinance No.67, entitled “An Ordinance Providing for the Regulation and Control of Vehicular Traffic and Parking upon the Streets, Highways and Roads in the Village of Loch Arbour, and Providing Penalties for the Violation Thereof, and Specifically Repealing Ordinance Nos. 10, 22, 23, and 34 and any and all other Ordinances and Sections Of Ordinances in Conflict Therewith.” Is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 306 – Taxi Stands – to read as follows:

Section 306. The following described location is hereby designated as a Taxi Stand:
Main Street: West side, beginning at a point 35 feet from the northerly curb line of Edgemont Avenue and extending to a point 25 feet northerly thereof.

SECTION B. Ordinance No. 67 entitled “An Ordinance Providing for the Regulation and Control of vehicular Traffic and Parking upon the Streets, Highways and Roads in the Village of Loch Arbour, and Providing Penalties for the Violation Thereof, and Specifically Repealing Ordinance Nos. 10, 22, 23 and 34, and any and all other Ordinances and sections of Ordinances in Conflict Therewith” is hereby amended by adding thereto Section 307 – Prohibiting Parking on Ocean Place (between 7 P.M. and 7 A.M.) During Certain times of the Year – to read as follows:

Section 307. When appropriately signed, from the 15th day of September to the following 15th day of May (both dates inclusive) in each year, no person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 7 o’clock in the evening and 7 o’clock of the following morning, prevailing time, on either side of Ocean place between Edgemont Drive and Elberon Avenue.

SECTION C. The within amending Ordinance shall become effective upon final passage and publication and approval by the Commissioner of Transportation of the State of New Jersey, as provided by law.
