

ORDINANCE 164

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 116 OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 1 (ADOPTION OF BUILDING CODE) OF ORDINANCE No. 25 ENTITLED `AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE STANDARD BUILDING CODE OF NEW JERSEY, AS THE STANDARD BUILDING CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR, AND TO ESTABLISH FIRE DISTRICTS AND RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, REPAIR, REMOVAL, DEMOLITION, EQUIPMENT, USE AND OCCUPANCY, LOCATION AND MAINTENANCE OF BUILDING AND STRUCTURES`, PARTICULARLY AS TO FLOOD HAZARD ELEVATION CONTROL".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Loch Arbour in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 116 of the Village of Loch Arbour entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 1 (ADOPTION OF BUKLDING CODE) OF ORDINANCE NO. 25 ENTITLED `AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE STANDARD BUILDING CODE OF NEW JERSEY, AS THE BUILDING CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR, AND TO ESTABLISH FIRE DISTRICTS AND RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION, REPAIR, REMOVAL, DEMOLITION, EQUIPMENT, USE AND OCCUPANCY, LOCATION AND MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES`, PARTICULARLY AS TO FLOOD HAZARD ELEVATION CONTROL". is hereby repealed.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
