

## ORDINANCE 216

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR, MONMOUTH COUNTY, NEW JERSEY TO ENTER INTO AN INTERLOCAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF ALLENHURST FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING PROVISION WHEREBY THE BOROUGH OF ALLENHURST WILL PROVIDE POLICE PROTECTION SERVICES TO THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR.

BE TI ORDAINED, by the Village Trustees of the Village of Loch Arbour, In the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. The Village of Loch Arbour is hereby authorized to enter into an Interlocal Services Agreement with the Borough of Allenhurst for the purpose of providing police protection services to the Village of Loch Arbour. This Agreement is made pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:8A-1 et seq. A true copy of this Agreement is attached hereto and made part hereof; shall be filed with the Village Clerk; and be available for public inspection subsequent to the introduction of this Ordinance.

Section 2. The Interlocal Services Agreement authorized by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 1989.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the forgoing Ordinance was introduced at a meeting of the Trustees of the Village of Loch Arbour, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1987, and was then read for the first tome.

The said Ordinance will be further considered for final passage by the Board of Trustees at the Village Offices at 7:30 P.M. on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1987.
