

ORDINANCE 31
(ADOPTED MARCH 10, 1961)

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND REGULATING THE USE OF PUBLIC STREETS IN THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR, PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS RELATIVE TO THE PARKING OF VEHICLES UPON SUCH STREETS; PROVIDING FOR PURCHASE, LEASING, AQUING, INSTALLATION, OPERATION, MAINTENANCE, SUPERVISION, REGULATION AND CONTROL OF THE USE OF PARKING METERS AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF; DEFINING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PARKING METER ZONES UPON THE PUBLIC STREET AND FOR AN ENFORCEMENT THEREOF AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

WHEREAS, because of traffic conditions that have existed in certain sections of the Village of Loch Arbour, the free movement of traffic in those sections is, and has been, impeded for a long period of time, and it is desired to improve the same;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the board of Trustees of the Village of Loch Arbour, Monmouth County, State of New Jersey:

Section 1. Definitions

Whenever in this ordinance the terms STREET, ROADWAY, SIDEWALK, and VEHICLE are used, they shall have the meaning respectively ascribed to them in New Jersey Statute, Title 39, Chapter 1, section 1.

Whenever in this ordinance the following terms are used, they shall have the meaning respectively ascribed to them in this section:

PARKING METERS. A mechanical device located upon a public street or sidewalk in a place regularly designed as a parking zone as hereinafter defined, which device shall record a certain number of minutes by the use of a clock mechanism determining the period of time for which parking privileges may be extended to the person so depositing a coin.

PARKING METER ZONE. A certain designated and marked off section of a public street within the marked boundaries where the vehicle may be temporarily parked and allowed to remain for such period of time as the parking meter attached thereto may indicate.

Section 2.

Parking meter zones as herein above described, are hereby created on the following street of the Village of Loch Arbour:

South side of Edgemont Drive from Norwood Avenue to Ocean Avenue; north side of Edgemont Drive from east side of Ocean Avenue to west side of Ocean Place; both sides Of Ocean Avenue south Edgemont drive to Asbury Park line; east side of Ocean Road between Edgemont Drive and Euclid Avenue; foot of Euclid Avenue east of Ocean Place and Ocean Road, and from time to time hereafter as traffic conditions require on such streets and avenues and other streets and avenues, or such other locations as shall be lawfully designated by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Loch Arbour for the location of such zones.

Section 3.

And in said parking meter zones the Superintendent of Parking Meters shall cause parking meters to be installed in such numbers and at such places as in his judgment may be necessary to the regulation, control and inspection of the parking of vehicles therein, and shall cause parking meter spaces to be designated as hereinafter provided. He shall fix the time limitations for legal parking in such zones and the hours during the day when the parking meter or meters must be used and when the time limitations shall be effective, in compliance with the provisions of this ordinance, and shall indicate the time limitations by designating the same on the parking meter or meters and by appropriate signs posted in proximity to said meter or meters in said zone.

Section 4.

The superintendent of Parking Meters of said Village is hereby authorized to carry out the terms of any contracts heretofore or hereafter entered into by the Board of Trustees of said Village for the purchase, leasing, acquiring, installation, operation, maintenance, supervision, regulation, and use of the parking meters provided for in this ordinance, whether for trial period or otherwise. The payment for such parking meters and installation to be provided for solely from receipts, funds and revenues obtained from the operation of said parking meters without in any manner obligating the Village to pay for the same from any other source.

Section 5.

The parking meters installed in the parking zones as established and provided for in Section 2 hereof, shall be placed upon the curb immediately adjacent to the individual parking places hereinafter described; provided, however, that no parking meters shall be installed in any area where standing or parking is prohibited by any laws of the State of New Jersey. Each parking meter shall be placed or set in such manner as to show or display by a signal that the parking space adjacent to such meter is or is not legally in use. Each parking meter installed shall indicate by a proper legend the legal parking time established by the Village and when operated shall indicate on and by its dial and pointer the duration of the period of legal parking and on the expiration of such period, shall indicate illegal or over parking.

Section 6.

The Superintendent of Parking Meters shall have markings painted or placed upon the curb and/or upon the street adjacent to each parking meter for the purpose of designating the parking space for which said meter is to be used and each vehicle parking adjacent or next to any parking meter shall park
