

ORDINANCE NO. 294

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 8 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF LICENSES TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT RETAIL, FIXING RULES AND REGULATIONS REGARDING THE CONDUCT OF PLACES SO LICENSED AND PROVIDING FOR SUSPENSION AND REVOCATION OF ANY SUCH LICENSE AND FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF ANY OF THE RULES AND REGULATION PROMULGATED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR, MONMOUTH COUNTY, NEW JERSEY OR BY THE DIRECTOR OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL OF SAID STATE" SO AS TO INCREASE THE FEES FOR PLENARY RETAIL CONSUMPTION AND DISTRIBUTION LICENSES" AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN INCONSISTENT THEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Loch Arbour, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that the Ordinance referred to in the title hereof is amended and supplemented as follows:

Section 1. The license fees for the period from July 1 of each year to June 30 of the following year, inclusive, are hereby fixed and established as follows:

Section 2. All ordinances or part of ordinances inconsistent herewith are repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law, and a certified copy hereof shall be filed with the Director of the Division of Alcohol Beverage Control of the State of New Jersey.
