

ORDINANCE NO. 300

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 299 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE ON-STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Loch Arbour, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 299 of the Village of Loch Arbour is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

In addition to any other penalty provided by New Jersey statute, any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic and any police officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage, which may result from such removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.

Section 2. Saving Clause

- a. Except as modified herein, Ordinance No. 299 is readopted without further modification.
- b. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- c. If any section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subparagraph, clause or provision so adjudged and remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 3. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
