

ORDINANCE NO. 337

AN ORDINANCE TO FIX AND DETERMINE THE SALARIES AND WAGES
TO BE PAID TO THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE
VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY,
AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 295 AND
ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF
ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT THEREWITH

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOCH
ARBOUR, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY, as follows:

Section 1. The annual salaries to be paid to certain officers or
employees of the Village of Loch Arbour shall be as follows:

Beach Manager	\$5,000.00	\$25,000.00
C-1 Licensed Sewage System Operator	\$1,000.00	\$5,000.00
Zoning/Local Code Official	\$1,000.00	\$5,000.00
Superintendent of Parking Meters	\$1,000.00	\$5,000.00
Clerk, Planning Board (per meeting or meeting equivalent)	\$150.00	\$500.00
License Inspection	\$100.00	\$500.00
Registrar of Vital Statistics	\$100.00	\$500.00
Director, Local Assistance	\$100.00	\$500.00
Acting Clerk (per diem)	\$75.00	\$150.00

Section 2. Wages to be paid to hourly employees shall be a minimum of
\$5.25 per hour to a maximum of \$20.00 per hour.

Section 3. Salaries may be paid in annual, quarterly, monthly or semi-
monthly installments with the exception of hourly employees, who must
be paid weekly or bi-weekly in accordance with State Statute.

Section 4. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, which are
inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of
such inconsistency.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final
passage and publication as required by law.
